



Studio Policy

Welcome!

I'm so excited for you to join me at MGA Studios. My goal is to foster a love and appreciation of art in children, and enrich all levels of artistic abilities. I offer a variety of classes from group to private that will explore different mediums and techniques. Class sizes will vary based on subject and age-group, and please note that all classes have limited seats. This helps me better serve each student in the class and to maximize their creative experience.

Payment

Tuition for the group classes is \$170, with a \$30 non refundable supply fee, to total \$200 for a 6 class session. Each class will last an hour. The last class of every session will be an hour and a half, and will include a small gallery show for the children and their favorite adults. I will teach the children how to prepare for an art show, hang their work, and proper etiquette for a gallery show. I will also provide light refreshments for the gallery show. Class supply fee is non-refundable and must be paid to hold your spot in class. Refunds will not be available after classes have begun.

Tuition is due at registration. This allows me to keep my supply fee low by purchasing the art supplies early and at a discount.

Make up Lessons

There will be no makeup lessons if class is missed. If I need to cancel due to an emergency, I will offer one make up class within a week of the canceled class.

Homework

There will be homework every week. I will require that they do 5 sketches a week, and will check their sketchbooks every class, so please help them remember to bring them to class. I will give them their sketchbooks and pencils on the first day of class.

What to wear

Being an artist is messy business, so please make sure whatever they wear to class is ok getting dirty. I will provide an apron for them to wear while they are here.

Studio Routine

You can drop your child off 5 minutes early to give them time to settle in and get set up for the day. I will have a small starter activity for them to do as soon as they enter the studio while we wait for everyone to arrive. At the end of the hour, you are welcome to come to the door, or if you'd prefer I send them out, just send me a text. Please do not park in the driveway, there is plenty of space in front of the house and yard.

Gallery Shows

As mentioned above, we will have a small show on the last day of the session. We also will have a large group show in early June when the final session ends that will allow each student from the 3 sessions to hang their favorite work of art. This gives them the opportunity to have up to 3 pieces in the show if they attend all 3 sessions, and also a great time to show grandparents and family members how awesome their art is. I'm really excited to show the children how to frame and prepare their art for a gallery. They will also learn how to title and price their artwork. I will provide the supplies they need to hang their art.

Thank you for giving me the privilege of teaching your children. I am so excited to see what they accomplish.
